SOLACTIVE TELEMEDICINE & DIGITAL HEALTH INDEX

SELECTION

- The index is designed to track performance of companies that have or are expected to have a significant exposure to the fields of telemedicine and/or digital health
- Using keywords that describe the index theme, the algorithm identifies and ranks companies according to the frequency with which the company is referenced in relation to the specific keywords
- The 40 highest ranking companies are determined as the final index components

SELECTION POOL

- Listed in one of the countries that are part of Developed Markets, South Korea, and Taiwan. Additionally, ADRs of any company whose primary listing is in a country that is part of Emerging Markets are eligible
- Generate at least 50% of their revenues from telemedicine and/or digital health related business operations
- Share Class Market Capitalization of at least \$200 million for new additions, and \$160 million for existing constituents
- Average Daily Value Traded in the last 6 months of at least \$2 million for new additions, and \$1.4 million for existing constituents
- Free float percentage of total shares outstanding of at least 10% or a minimum free float market capitalization of \$1 billion
- The index may include companies that:
 - Connect physicians and patients digitally, facilitating a range of medical activities that include diagnosis, treatment, and medication management, as well as offering online pharmaceutical services, and/or providing internet healthcare platforms (“Telemedicine”)
 - Collect, produce, utilize, and/or store data for healthcare related statistical and/or computational analyses, including artificial intelligence analyses and cloud-based analytics platforms (“Healthcare Analytics”)
 - Develop healthcare devices which automatically transmit data and results to patients and/or physicians to assist in real-time, dynamic patient treatment and preventative care (“Connected Healthcare Devices”), and/or
 - Innovate healthcare provider management processes including patient intake, staffing solutions, revenue/billing cycle management, digital healthcare security, as well as doctor/hospital search, booking and/or rating services for patient use (“Administrative Digitization”)

WEIGHTING SCHEME

- The index is free float market cap-weighted with a single security cap of 4%, and a single security floor of 0.3%

REBALANCES/REVIEWS

- The index follows a semi-annual rebalance schedule. Adjustments are made on the second Friday in May and November each year
