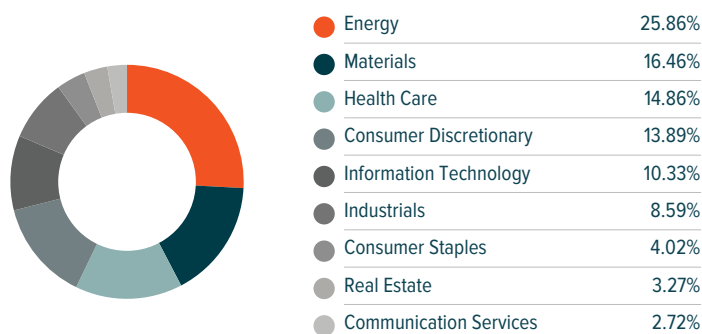

Global X U.S. Cash Flow Kings 100 Index The Underlying Index is designed to provide exposure to large- and mid-capitalization U.S. equity securities that exhibit high free cash flow yields relative to the eligible universe of companies, as determined by the Index Administrator.

(1) Free cash flow is the cash a company generates after accounting for operating and capital expenditures. Free cash flow yield is defined as a company's free cash flow per share, divided by its enterprise value per share.
