








Given Emergency Situations, Surveyed Individuals Are Even More Open to Automated Processes






Wearable Technology May Provide Peace of Mind for Those With Elderly Loved Ones






Despite Mild Skepticism, Most Americans Are Open to New Forms of Medication Delivery






